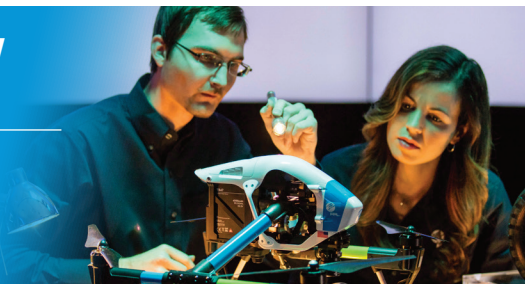

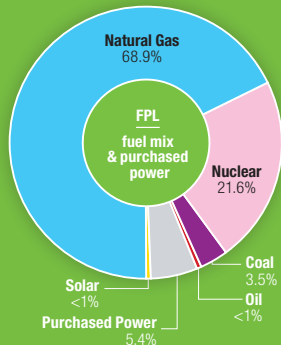

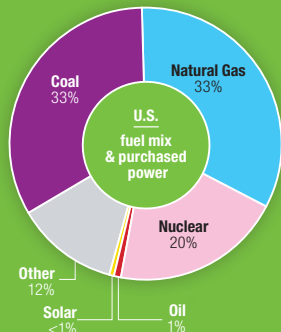
## What powers Florida businesses?

See how we compare to the rest of the nation.

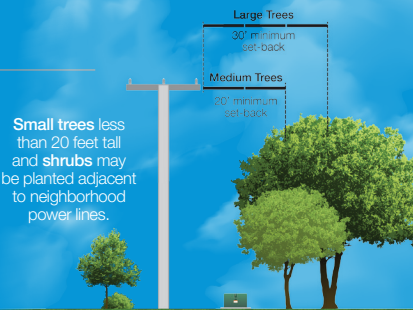


Major energy sources and percent share of total U.S. electricity generation in 2015

## Stay safe around power lines

- » Plant only small tree species or shrubs near power lines
- » Keep medium and large trees, including palms, at a safe distance
- » Always keep transformers clear of vegetation
- » Never attempt to trim vegetation near power lines
